

## Tuesday, 25 June

At **6 pm**, at the Mollet del Rec staircase, there will be a **handover of the Arjau flag and the presentation of the boats *La Muga* and *Octavia*** from Cádiz, which this year will join the Cambrils fleet of lateen sailboats.

At **7.30 pm**, at Les Basses Civic Centre, a round table on **Cast Net Fishing in Cambrils**, with a preview of photographs from the Cambrils Municipal Archive and an example of a hundred-year-old cast net. This will be followed by explanations from fishermen who practiced this form of fishing in the twentieth century.

## Thursday, 28 June

From **6 pm**, **demonstration of traditional sailing** off Regueral beach. To see the full demonstration, we recommend you stand on the Llevant wharf in Cambrils Port.

At **6.30 pm**, at the start of the Llevant wharf in Cambrils Port, opening of the tented area with booths selling **Cast Net Festival** and **Arjau** t-shirts.

From **7 pm**, at Regueral beach, start of the eighth edition of the **CAST NET FESTIVAL. Traditional fishing in Cambrils**, featuring a recreation of bygone trades: cast net makers, adze masters, net menders, master sailmakers, lacemakers, traditional sailing techniques, etc.

At **7.30 pm**, at Regueral beach, casting of the *rall* net by Joan Rom, aka “Migranya”, and the *rossegall* net in collaboration with the “Vileros i Mariners” spoken dance troupe of Cambrils.

At **8 pm**, at Regueral beach, **cast netting** by fishermen from the Cambrils Brotherhood of Fishermen, in collaboration with the Vent d'Estrop rowing club and anyone else who would like to come down to the beach to help stretch the ropes. **Spreading the cast nets** on the sand followed by an **old-time fish auction** by Francesc Benaiges Quebra, with a performance by the “Vileros i Mariners” spoken dance troupe of Cambrils.

## Saturday, 29 June

From **7.30 pm**, at the Soral pontoons of the Ribera wharf in the port, a **mass hoisting of sails** by the Cambrils lateen sailboat fleet, symbolically joining the Festival of Sant Pere parade with Cambrils' other festive components.
